# Contests

Start collecting your FUN BUTTONS now. Go to the Information Booth to purchase your FUN BUTTON bracelet for \$2.00. Then go to the different departments, find the person with the "Fun Button ASK ME RIBBON" and tell them you are there to collect a FUN BUTTON. They will ask you a question and you have to answer the question correctly. The answer will be somewhere in that department.
